

2000 MEMBER CLUB GUIDELINES
Kansas East Conference
The United Methodist Church

The club exists to provide a means whereby persons may contribute to special funds or projects of church growth and expansion within the bounds of the Kansas East Conference of The United Methodist Church. Persons join the Club by signing a pledge. Each regular member pledges to pay at least \$10 per call and each sustaining member pledges to pay at least \$25 per call. No more than two calls may be issued in any calendar year. Persons may terminate membership by written cancellation to the Club c/o the conference Treasurer's Office. In response to the need stated in the call, members may give any amount above their pledge if they believe they are led to do so.

PROJECTS ELIGIBLE FOR CLUB CALLS ARE:

- A. Redevelopment and/or relocation of existing churches to serve new areas of residential growth.
- B. Replacement, renovation or expansion of Ethnic Minority Local Church building.
- C. Provision of funds for capital improvements for special mission projects within the bounds of the Kansas East Conference.
- D. Assistance to an existing church for a new building addition.
- E. Assistance to an existing church to build a new parsonage when special conditions of missional strategies, parish development or similar needs warrant.

PROCESS, POLICY & PROCEDURE

1. Project requests for approval as call recipients may come from any local church or group therein. Church council or charge conference approval is required. Requests are to be mailed no later than January 15 of any current year for a decision effective the same year. All requests received with a postmark later than January 15 will be returned to senders for re-submission the following year. All requests are to be mailed to the Kansas East Conference, Attn: 2000 Member Grant, PO Box 4187, Topeka, KS 66604-0187.
2. The Cabinet examines requests and reports recommended projects to the Revitalization Task Force.
3. The Revitalization Task Force authorizes the final selection of projects for each call. Once the projects are decided for the calls, written notification will be sent to each church that submitted a proposal. A church not selected to receive funding, may re-submit the same proposal the following year, but no proposals will be held over for consideration.
4. The Revitalization Task Force will issue calls about April 1 and October 1 of each year.
5. A brief report of a previous call is included in the succeeding call.
6. Club membership and financial records shall be maintained in the conference Treasurer's Office.
7. Promotion and recruitment of 2000 Member Club membership shall be the responsibility of the Revitalization Task Force and local churches.
8. Administration of the process shall be the responsibility of the Revitalization Task Force.
9. Specified funds designated but not used within the following 12 months of a call will revert back to the Revitalization Task Force for evaluation and/or reassignment.
