Kansas East Conference Bishop's Round-up for Hunger 2011 REPORT

Dear friends,

This has been a successful year for Round-up. Preparing Round-up statistics is one of the most fun things I do. I see all of the reports that churches send and celebrate wonderful victories with them. Some have exhibited sacrificial stewardship giving.

Any Bishop's Round-up report needs to recognize that this same sacrificial attitude is exhibited in many of our large churches that do no report on the Round-up form. If this information were reported, the total would be doubled or tripled. Their work and contributions are truly magnificent.

The following seem important enough to especially point out:

- We had a very high grand total while also seeing significant changes within the different categories.
- Food brought to Round-up decreased from \$27,000+ in 2010 to \$23,000+ in 2011 while two food distributed close to home categories increased from \$71,000+ in 2010 to \$109,000+ in 2011.
