CRAFT SALE

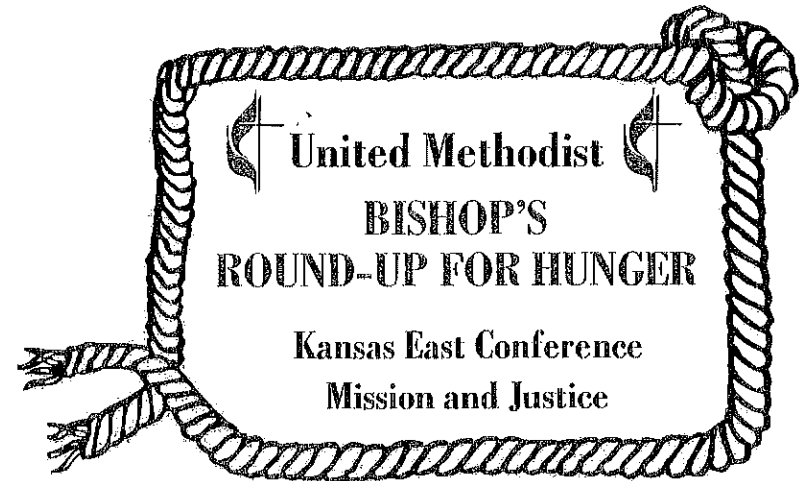

BISHOP'S ROUND-UP FOR HUNGER NEEDS

The Bishop's Round-Up for Hunger is a project of Global Ministries in the Kansas East Conference of the United Methodist Church. We need the following items which are gathered from churches and distributed to those in need within the state and abroad. Box label color is in parentheses. **NO PLASTIC BAGS, PLEASE.**

CRITICAL

FOOD COMMERCIALY PREPARED (green)

NO COMMODITIES OR GLASS JARS

(12 Items per box or case, please)

Please use box size that "Grandma" could carry.

Suggested items:

Fruit	Corn
Green beans	Macaroni & cheese
Mixed vegetables	Cereal (that children like)
Tuna	Soup (tomato, chicken noodle)
Peanut butter	Canned meat
1 lb. dried beans	Spaghetti
1 lb. Rice	Spaghetti sauce
Crackers	Ramen noodles

When purchasing food items, please purchase regular sizes. Also, remember to purchase foods you and your family like.

The foods listed above are the items that are needed most for food boxes. Case lots are encouraged. Please indicate the number of items in each box.

HEALTH KITS - NEW ITEMS ONLY (yellow)

1 bath towel	1 bar of soap	Shampoo
1 washcloth	1 tube toothpaste	Deodorant
1 comb or brush	1 toothbrush (packaged)	Body lotion

Wrap inside bath towel and tie securely or put in a two-gallon self-closing plastic bag.

SCHOOL KITS - (purple) *Put items in 2-gallon plastic bags*

2 unsharpened pencils with erasers
2 wide-line theme books or notebooks (not wire bound)
Scissors - small, blunt 1 tube of glue
1 box 24 crayons Washable markers (8 colors)
1 box colored pencils Erasers (pink)

LAYETTES - NEW ITEMS ONLY (white)

Pkg sleepers	Baby wipes	Baby socks
Pkg receiving blankets	Baby soap	Blanket

Wrap inside blanket and tie securely.

DIAPERS - (white-D)

Disposable diapers in all sizes. (Pack separately from Layettes) Also mark on the box the sizes included.

BEDDING - (orange) - No Bed Spreads

Good clean sheets, blankets and pillowcases.

PAPER SUPPLIES - (black)

Toilet paper, paper towels

TOYS & GAMES - NEW (blue)

Toys and games for all ages, especially teens.

INFANT'S & CHILDREN'S CLOTHES - (red)

Clean, usable clothes for boys and girls; infant's clothes are in greatest need. Mark INFANT on those boxes.

ADULT CLOTHES - (pink)

Clean, usable men's and women's clothes are needed.
